BCGC is a private club open to members and guests.

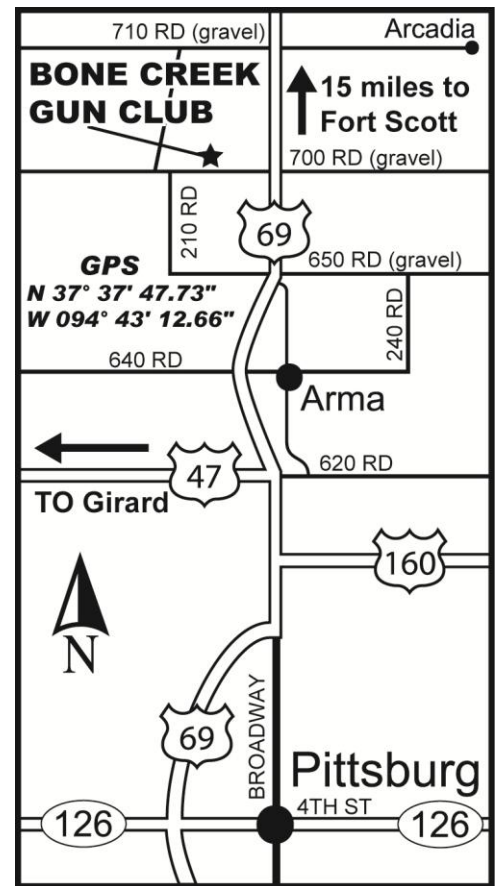
## Ranges include –

- 1) 25 yard pistol range with covered firing line
- 2) Regulation skeet range with both remote competition throwers and manual clay throwers
- 3) 200 yard rifle range with covered firing line

## Monthly Meeting –

The second Thursday of each month at 7:00 PM in Napoli's Italian Restaurant (13<sup>th</sup> & Broadway). Those interested gather at 6:00 PM for great Italian food before the meeting is gaveled in at 7:00 PM. Meetings typically last less than 30 minutes.

**BCGC is located 15 miles north of Pittsburg, ¾ mile west of Hwy 69 on the north side of 700 RD.**



## Competition –

BCGC hosts a sanctioned USPSA practical pistol match on the first Sunday of each month (except major holidays and KS deer rifle season). Most months a side long gun/multi-gun practical match is held and occasionally a full-on 3 gun match. Matches are open to the public.
